Doha Film Institute Grants Programme - FILM General Guidelines

1. Funding is available through the Doha Film Institute Grants Programme (the "**Programme**") to international film projects that satisfy the below listed criteria.

Development, production and post-production funding is available for short and feature-length projects. Funding is subject to the director's nationality. Please refer to our *Eligibility Per Region* table for details (next page).

For features, a first- or second-time director must be attached. For the purposes of the Programme, a first- or second-time filmmaker is defined as one who is directing their first or second feature-length (65 minutes and over) narrative or documentary film.

Post-production funding is also available for feature films by **established directors** from Qatar and the MENA region.

2. The Institute does not apply restrictions on form or genre.

3. Short films are defined as 5 to 30 minutes in duration, while feature films are 65 minutes or longer.

4. A director may submit only one project per Grants session.

5. Applications for production or post-production funding for feature-length projects must have a producer and production company attached.

6. Projects that have received **development funding in prior Grants sessions are only eligible to apply for postproduction funding consideration**. Projects that have received **production funding in prior sessions are not eligible to apply for post-production funding.**

7. Resubmissions must include a detailed report of all relevant changes, since their last submission. A project is considered for funding no more than twice per same stage of production.

8. Funding for experimental, essay, and VR projects is available to Qatar and MENA applicants only.

9. There are two annual Grants submission cycles, always in January and July. Check our website for the exact dates.

10. A director who has completed a film of 30+ minutes is not eligible to apply for funding for a short film.

11. A director applying for funding for a feature film must have directed at least one short film.

12. If a project is co-directed, both directors must be first- or second-time filmmakers and meet all eligibility criteria.

13. If a project under consideration has its world premiere prior to the Jury deliberations (Stage 2), it is no longer eligible.

14. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Funding Consideration Stages

Eligible projects are considered for funding in two stages:

<u>Stage 1</u>: The artistic material and the director's previous work(s) are reviewed. DFI will notify applicants within two months of the submission deadline, informing them whether their project has been shortlisted or not.

Supporting documentation may be submitted in Arabic, French and/or English during Stage 1.

If the English versions are translations, applicants are encouraged to submit their materials in their original language too. Whenever possible and applicable, previous works should be submitted with English subtitles.

<u>Stage 2</u>: If your project is shortlisted, further materials must be submitted to DFI within one week of notification. The Programme Jury will thereafter evaluate shortlisted projects and the final selection will be announced within two months of the Stage 2 submission deadline.

Should your project be shortlisted, any documents originally submitted in Arabic or French, including scripts, treatments and/or rough cuts, must then be provided in English and/or with English subtitles.
